DO'S AND DON'TS AFTER A FIRE

What's Next?

- DO** Contact your insurance company to file a claim.
- DO** Consider the Red Cross for assistance.
- DO** Make arrangements to protect your property from further damage or theft.
- DO** Take with you any valuables.
- DO NOT** Attempt to clean or remove soot from your belongings.
- DO NOT** Enter your property until it has been inspected and deemed safe to re-enter.



The Fire Damage Restoration Process

- First Responders and Paul Davis Emergency Recovery Coordinator (ERC) arrive on scene
- Consider the American Red Cross
- Notify Insurance
- Property released by First Responders
- Paul Davis secures the site preventing further damage
- Retrieve 2 weeks of clothing and key documents
- Meet your Paul Davis Team
- Emergency Work completed
- Materials selections made
- Property restored
